





1. Cut out the Cowboy Character. Make folds (away from you) along the white dotted lines, including the tabs. Fold the legs toward you and the knees away from you. Glue tab A to the backside of the Cowboy's back. This should create a rectangle shape.
2. Put glue on the 8 small tabs (four on each side) on the sides of the Cowboy's head. Then glue them to the backside of the Cowboy's head. Make sure you hold each one in place for a few seconds before you move on. Next, glue tab B to the back of the side of the cowboy's head.
3. Cut out the left arm. Keep it connected in the middle and fold it in half. Bend the tabs toward you then you glue the backsides of the arm and rope (leaving glue off the tabs) together. Be sure to not glue the tabs to each other. Once the arm and rope are dry, put glue on the spread open tabs and glue to the left side of the Cowboy.

NOTE: If the left arm with the rope proves too difficult to cut out, you can substitute it for the alternate left arm.

4. Repeat step 3 with the right arm and glue it to the right side of the Cowboy.
5. Cut out the Cowboy's hat. Keep it connected in the middle and fold it in half. Bend the tabs toward you then glue the backsides of the hat (leaving glue off the tabs) together. Next, put glue on the spread open tabs and glue them to the top of the Cowboy's head.

Your Cowboy is now complete! Place him on the edge of a shelf or table, or give him as a gift!
